

## Ramadan Competition

### Terms & Conditions

1. This competition is open to anyone who is 16 years of age or under and is attending either infant, junior or secondary school in the UK.
2. The theme of the competition is **My Ramadan** and entry to the competition can be made by submitting one of the following:
  - a. Produce a piece of creative writing on “My Ramadan”.
  - b. Write a poem on “My Ramadan”.
  - c. Draw a poster representing “My Ramadan”.
  - d. Produce an audio clip of up to 5 minutes on “My Ramadan”
  - e. Produce a video clip of up to 5 minutes on “My Ramadan”
3. There are three entry categories:
  - Category 1: Ages 4 to 7 (infant)
  - Category 2: Ages 8 to 11 (junior)
  - Category 3: Ages 12 to 16 (secondary)
4. For each category, there are 7 prizes to be won:

First	£100 Amazon voucher (1 winner)
Second	£50 Amazon voucher (2 winners)
Third	£25 Amazon voucher (4 winners)
5. Maximum 2 entries is permitted per person. Entries are to be submitted online via [www.ukim.org](http://www.ukim.org).
6. All entries submitted to the competition must be original. They cannot be copies of any existing work. If any submitted work is deemed to have been plagiarised from unreferenced sources will be disqualified and will not be considered.
7. By entering the competition, this constitutes consent for us to use your entry, name or photos for editorial or publicity purposes, should you be a winner. Please ensure parents/carers have given their consent on the submission form.
8. The winners will be chosen by a judging panel which will be made up of representatives of UK Islamic Mission. The judges’ decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
9. Every effort will be made to notify the winners by email by midday (12 noon) 15<sup>th</sup> June 2020. Winners must respond within 14 days of receiving their notification or an alternative winner may be chosen. We cannot be held responsible for non-functional email address provided by you at the time of entering the competition.
10. By entering the competition, entrants are deemed to have accepted these terms and conditions.
